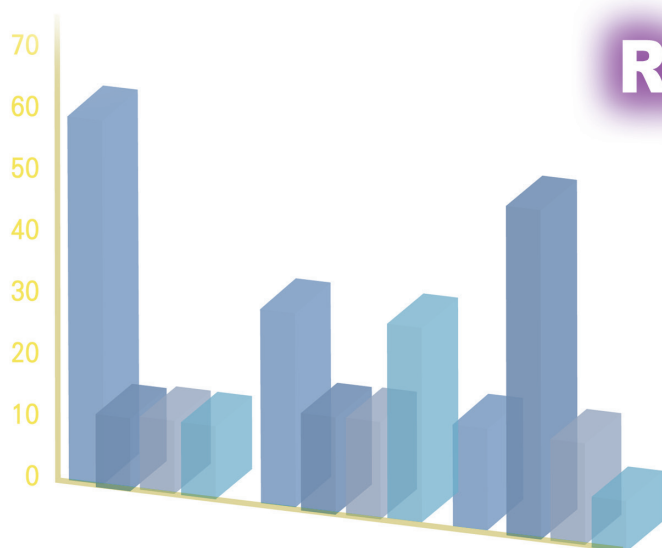


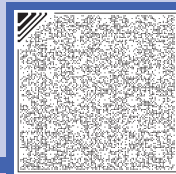

Recidivism Rate in 2017

The “Report on the Recidivism of Sentenced Macao Residents” has been formulated jointly by the Social Welfare Bureau and the Correctional Services Bureau based on the statistics of Macao residents given prison sentences and non-custodial sentences and using the criteria of whether these sentenced Macao residents re-offended and were convicted again within two years of completion of their prison sentences or non-custodial sentences. The statistical analysis of the recidivism of sentenced Macao residents in 2017 has been completed. Please refer to the following for details:

Recidivism of Macao residents given prison sentences

Year	2017	
Item	No. of people	Percentage
Reoffence within two years of release	17 (13 of whom were sentenced to imprisonment again)	9.9% (Of which 7.6% were sentenced to imprisonment again)

Recidivism of Macao residents given non-custodial sentences

Year	2017	
Item	No. of people	Percentage
Reoffence within two years of completion of the relevant measures	14 (7 of whom were sentenced to imprisonment)	6.7% (Of which 3.3% were sentenced to imprisonment)
Total	210 ^②	100%
